## **Polished and textured plaster maintenance information**

### **Cleaning of Plaster finishes**

Our plaster finishes are not reliant on excess wax to make them shiny as they are naturally shiny, the surface should be treated with the same respect as any natural material and may require some routine maintenance in high traffic areas. We recommend that a tile or wood is used at the bottom of walls to protect from cleaning machines and mops. Wipe often with a soft dry cloth to remove dust etc. Do not use water as it will dilute dust and could stain the plaster. Bleach and cleaning agents may reduce staining on the plaster but always try a test first in an inconspicuous area and monitor for a few days. Scuffs and marks are sometimes easily removed by an eraser. Do not sand the surface as it will damage the surface. Many stains on this plaster will disappear over time as the lime will eventually eat away many stains. We can provide special cleaners and staff to remove marks and dirt on the surface.

### **Damage**

The Walleffects range of plaster finishes are tough but can be damaged. If damage occurs we advise it is repaired as soon as possible to reduce the risk of future damage. This can be done by Walleffects applicators or by touch up kits which can be supplied by us. In areas of high traffic wear and tear should be monitored as repairs and extra protection are easily done in the early stages.
